Dear Ms. Rose:

On July 8, 2026, Brazoria County received your enclosed request made under the Texas Public Information Act (the "Act"). Your request was forwarded to the Brazoria County District Attorney's Office. This Office represents Brazoria County, which includes the Sheriff's Office, in matters related to open records requests.

On July 22, 2026, this office sent you a copy of our request for a determination to the Office of the Attorney General, and a labor cost estimate associated with the records you seek. On July 24, 2026, this office received your payment.

Regarding the available responsive information, please note that the information you requested contains information that relates to:

- a motor vehicle operator's or driver's license or permit issued by an agency of this state or another state or country;
- a motor vehicle title or registration issued by an agency of this state or another state or country;
- a personal identification document issued by an agency of this state or another state or country or a local agency authorized to issue an identification document; and/or
- credit card, debit card, charge card, and/or access device number – which includes insurance policy numbers.

The above information is confidential under Tex. Gov't Code §§ 552.130 and/or 552.136. Our office is prohibited by law from releasing this information to you, and therefore we have removed this information from the enclosed information we are providing you with.

You have the right to appeal our decision to withhold this information from you. Instructions for appeal are at the end of this letter. If you do not want to appeal, you do not need to do anything else. Please note that we are only withholding specific categories of information that are

confidential under §§ 552.130 and/or 552.136. We will process the rest of your request for information in accordance with the terms of the Public Information Act.

Generally, we must request a ruling from the Texas Attorney General before we can withhold any of the information you requested. However, §§ 552.130 and/or 552.136 allow us to withhold this specific information without requesting a ruling from the attorney general.

Lastly, the responsive information may also contain dates of birth and social security numbers which are confidential under the Act, therefore that information may have also been redacted.

How to appeal the withholding of information under Gov't Code sections 552.130 and/or 552.136

If you wish to appeal the withholding of information discussed on the previous page, you must send the following to the attorney general:

- 1) a signed, written statement indicating your wish to appeal the withholding of information;
- 2) the name of the governmental body that withheld information from you;
- 3) the date you made your original request for information; and
- 4) a copy of your original request for information, or if you are unable to provide a copy, a description of your original request for information.

You may also submit written comments stating why you think the information should be released to you, but you are not required to do so.

Send your appeal by mail to the attorney general at:

Within forty-five business days after receiving all of the above-listed items necessary to file your appeal, the attorney general will issue a written ruling on the matter. You will receive a copy of this ruling in the mail.
